It creates a striking but relaxed setting that intensifies emotions. It is not a blank canvas – there's too much history in the walls for us to call ourselves that - but there is plenty of scope for you to make your mark.

The Grange is only available for weddings a limited number of times a year


## Lake House Garden

A beautiful, 3-acre private walled garden which originally supplied fruit, vegetables, flowers and herbs for The Grange.



### The Grange CLASSIC NV




